

## Hoosic Valley CSD 2024-2025

**At this summer's Board Retreat in July, the Board of Education met with school administrators to establish measurable District Goals for the 2024-25 school year and then set corresponding Board Goals for the school year.**

### **District Goals**

- The percentage of students in Grade K-8 scoring on or above grade level for benchmark i-Ready ELA assessments, will increase by at least 10% in 2024-25. The focus area to achieve this goal will be in vocabulary acquisition and usage.
- The percentage of students in Grades K-8 scoring on or above grade level for benchmark i-Ready Math assessments in the area of Geometry, will increase by at least 10% in 2024-25.
- Increase Parental involvement as measured by the following steps:
  - Increase the usage rate on Parentsquare by 10%
  - Increase the amount of parents accessing online report cards by 10%
  - Survey parents at the beginning and end of the school year
  - Share i-ready parent reports to all parents of students taking I-ready assessments
  - Host 4 evening "Community Conversations" for families to learn about benchmark assessments, the IEP process, FAFSA, and how to help your child with academics at home
- Enhance the Community and Culture of our outstanding Faculty and Staff in the following ways:
  - Utilize our updated website and social media to increase the number of positive stories and posts of Faculty, Staff and students by at least 25%
  - Promote participation at student events through increased communication
  - Partner with local community organizations for hosting and/or coordination of 3 community events

### **Board Goals**

- The Board of Education will schedule two Board Workshops (Fall & Spring) to discuss the new graduation measures, review current offerings and review recommendations from administration in order to make financial and programmatic decisions.
- The Board of Education will increase communication and understanding of the board of education's visibility, roles and responsibilities through the design of a new website page and other avenues.
- The Board of Education will review and discuss academic data quarterly to evaluate student progress and will utilize the data in making financial and programmatic decisions.
- The Board of Education will request and review "Roadmaps to Success" from the various levels monthly to ensure the cycle of continuous improvement.
